Statement on India's Attack on Pakistan & Push-in to Bangladesh: A Call for Calm and Regional Security

The South Asia Initiative (SAI) expresses deep concern over the recent attack by India on Pakistani territory. Such military actions not only escalate bilateral tensions but also jeopardize the stability, economic cooperation, and peace-building efforts of the entire South Asian region.

Continued conflict between two major powers undermines the hopes and opportunities of the region's people.
